Atlantic Trust Is a Top Wealth Manager

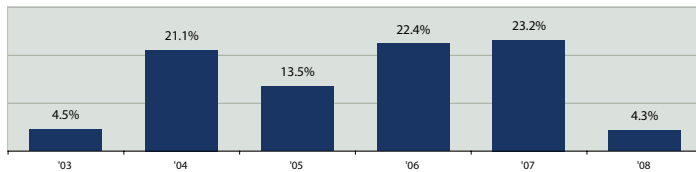

In the highly regarded *Barron's* annual survey of "Top Wealth Managers in the U.S.," released in mid-October, Atlantic Trust Private Wealth Management ranks among the nation's top financial institutions.

Atlantic Trust received a ranking on the first-ever *Barron's* \$10 Million Club, placing 19 out of 27 firms that disclosed assets in accounts with \$10 million-plus. "In a market of great turbulence, every single client is reassessing the level of confidence and trust they have in the institutions that advise them," *Barron's* states. Atlantic Trust offerings are tailored for clients with more than \$5 million in investable assets. As the wealthy shift their assets to stable, more conservative, yet highly competitive wealth management firms, Atlantic Trust is positioned to serve this clientele. Our firm advises individuals, families, foundations and endowments whose approach to investing is strongly focused on the preservation and long-term growth of their capital.

Additionally, Atlantic Trust ranked 32 out of 40 by assets under management for individual clients with accounts of \$1 million or more, as of June 30. While our ranking in 2007 was 30 on the list, the change is due to a new respondent firm to the list and another firm which experienced substantial growth due to acquisitions. We are among a select group of top wealth managers in the U.S. *Barron's* noted in a recent annual study that assets under management at the top 40 private banks increased just 4.3% in the year through June 30, versus 20%-plus in each of the previous two years (see chart below). With our attractive platform, Atlantic Trust stands to generate new growth from the current shifting of assets.
